

Master of Theology

MASTER OF THEOLOGY (MTh)

The Master of Theology is a coursework program designed for those who hold at least a Bachelor of Theology (or equivalent) and who wish to pursue theological studies in greater depth and with greater rigour. It includes either a specialisation of six subjects in one discipline or sub-discipline, or in-depth studies of three subjects in two or more disciplines or sub-disciplines, along with the opportunity for a focused research project.

Course Structure

108 credit points (12 course subjects) at AQF 8 and/or AQF 9 level (8500 and/or 9600 series)

- A maximum of four course subjects (36 credit points) may be taken at 8500 level
- All other subjects are taken at 9600 level
- Unit content may not be similar to that of subjects undertaken previously, e.g., in a Bachelor of Theology
- The Master of Theology requires either specialisation or in-depth studies:
 - A specialisation comprises six subjects (54 credit points) in a discipline or sub-discipline.
 - In-depth studies require 3 subjects (27 credit points) in two or more disciplines or sub-disciplines.
- At least one generic research unit (9 credit points) must be included.

Entrance Requirements

A Bachelor of Theology (AQF7) or Bachelor of Ministry (AQF7 - with sufficient Bible and Theology subjects

Articulation to Other SCD Awards

Students are eligible to articulate to the Master of Philosophy, Doctor of Ministry, or Doctor of Theology offered by the Sydney College of Divinity provided they meet the entry requirements (including undertaking a specified research component within the Master of Theology).
